- Team Forms: Make sure you have all of your required paperwork completed. As a minimum, you need copies of your Style form (4), Outside Assistance form (1), Cost form (1), and the optional Media Release Opt-Out form (1). - Please respect all teams. Show your Omer Spirit and help one another. Keep the hallways passable and keep the noise level to a low roar.
 - Note: Watch for areas of the school that are off-limits, and stay within those boundaries
- Please clean up! Pick up and deposit your trash, and clean up any makeup or other spills. Please DO NOT dispose of any sets or props at the school - the schools are not equipped for this volume of material, AND you may need them if you advance to the state tournament!
- Be on time. Arrive at your site 20 minutes prior to your scheduled performance times: long-term and spontaneous.
- Support all the teams. Watch others perform and cheer them on!
- Come to the awards ceremony at 6:00 PM! Line up for a banner parade into the ceremony at 5:45 PM and show your support for your school and all the teams in the region. (If you are a primary team, we understand that it can be a long day for younger students and certainly understand if the team decides to skip the ceremony.)
